English

In English, our core texts are 'Handa's Surprise', 'The Farm that Feeds Us' and 'The Queens Hat'.

Throughout the term the children will write a set of instructions guiding our audience to make a Fruit Smoothie. After this, we will move on to writing a narrative linked to another of our core texts, 'The Queens Hat'.

Daily phonics teaching and handwriting sessions will enable children to spell confidently and to write legibly and fluently using a neat pre-cursive handwriting style. In addition to this, children will experience a wide variety of text types during our daily whole class reading sessions to practise word reading and comprehension skills.
