Explore and talk about different forces they feel using magnets

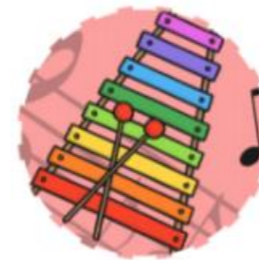
Preparation of our Early Years Garden to begin growing flowers, fruit and vegetables
