The Y6 School Sleepover – Friday 27th March 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are offering a very exciting opportunity for pupils in Year 6 to sleep over at school. This exciting, fun-filled evening is only open to children in Year 6.

The event will **start at 6pm** at school and pupils can be dropped off at reception. During the evening, we will be watching a film, playing some games, having a disco and much, much more! We will also be having hotdogs and snacks in the evening and continental breakfast in the morning. Drinks will be provided, however, children should also bring their own water bottle to refill throughout the evening. Pupils **will need to be picked up** from school the following day, Saturday 28th March at **9am**.

For the sleepover, children will be required to bring appropriate sleeping equipment with them, for example, sleeping bags and pillows. Airbeds are allowed, however, anything that children bring they must be able to assemble themselves. They will also need pyjamas, toothbrushes, toothpaste, individual medication and anything else you feel necessary. Boys will be sleeping in the dining room and girls will be sleeping in the hall. Medication must be handed in on arrival to a teacher when signing in with a completed medical form, which will be available if needed.

Please be aware that no mobile phones or electronics are allowed during The Sleepover and therefore must be left at home.

The price for this evening is £15 which will cover the cost of snacks and entertainment and will raise a small amount that we will put towards our Play in a week performance by The Young Theatre Company. Payment must be made for children to join us, via Arbor. Please also bring the slip below.

We hope that your child can join us for The Sleepover and take part in this activity.
