Dear Parents/Carers of Year 2

As part of our History topic on "What were seaside holidays like in the past?" we are delighted to announce that Year 2 will be visiting Cleethorpes.

This exciting trip will give the children the opportunity to explore a traditional seaside town and compare what a visit to the seaside was like in the past with what it is like today. During the visit, the children will take part in activities that support their learning and help bring our history topic to life.

The trip will take place on Monday 20th July 2026, we aim to leave St John's at 9am and return for 3pm.

The cost of the trip is £15, this will cover travel costs and an ice pop/ice cream. A payment has been set up on Arbor.

Please ensure that your child has either a packed lunch from home **NB: Due to severe allergies no egg or nuts please**, or if you would like to order a school packed lunch (Grab Bag), please do so through Arbor.

All Year 2 children are entitled to Universal Free School Meals (UFSM) but please make sure you order if you would like your child to have one.

Children will also need to bring a water bottle (no glass bottles or fizzy pop please) and a small bag to carry their belongings.

Children will need to wear full PE kit with a suitable coat and sensible footwear. Children will need to be at school for the usual start time and will be returning for normal pick up at 3pm.

If any child suffers from travel sickness, please make sure they take a tablet before the journey and, if medicine is required for the return journey, please inform the office prior to the trip, so that a medication form can be filled in.
