Dear Parents/Carers of Y5 in September,

We have made a provisional booking for a two nights/three days visit to a YHA centre in Whitby from **Monday 12th April to Wednesday 14th April 2027** and are offering all pupils in Year 5 the opportunity to take part.

During their stay, pupils will take part in outdoor adventure activities to develop their personal and teamwork skills. Activities have yet to be finalised and are subject to change due to weather and tides but could include: a coastal walk, jet polishing, team building activities, fossil hunting, a town trail and the Captain Cook Museum. The total cost will be £235 per child, and you will be able to pay in instalments, but the full amount must be paid before the trip. During the year, we will also be fundraising to help subsidise the full amount of the visit.

The price includes:

- accommodation at the YHA, plus travel costs,
- all activities, visits and materials for the programme of study,
- three main meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) from a wide menu choice.

If you would like your child to take part in this trip, we will need a £30 non-refundable deposit paying by **Tuesday 30th June**. The payment will be set up on Arbor.
