Dear Parents/Carers of Year 4,

Year 4 will be making a visit to Bassetlaw Museum in Retford to support their learning about Romans. During the day they will be taking part in different workshops where children will learn all about the Romans and their life in Britain. The trip is on Tuesday 16th September during usual school hours.

As costs can get quite expensive for trips, the total cost of the entrance, activities and coach will come to £11 per child, we are splitting the costs between this and the provisionally booked trip to Perlethorpe on 2nd March 2026. We hope this helps manage the expense of school trips to minimise costs over a longer period. A payment has been set up on School Money and the link will be sent to you for permission and payment.

Children will need to wear full school uniform, a waterproof coat/jacket and sensible footwear. They need to be at school for the usual start time and we will be back for normal pick up at 3pm.

If any child suffers from travel sickness, please make sure they take a tablet before the journey and if medicine is required for the return journey, please inform the office prior to the trip so that a medication form can be filled in.

Children will need a packed lunch and drink (no glass bottles or fizzy pop please).

NB: Due to severe allergies no egg or nuts please.

If you would like to order a school packed lunch, please do so through Swift Kitchen on the app or via a web browser. Children entitled to Free School Meals also need to order in this way.
