After-School Clubs - Summer Term 1

We're pleased to let you know that After School Clubs will begin again after the Easter holiday, on week beginning Monday 28th April 2025.

All clubs will run for **four weeks (three weeks for Monday Clubs, due to May Day Bank Holiday)** and are open to each year group as shown, where available. Numbers for each activity are limited and where we have more pupils showing an interest in a club than places available, names will be pulled from a hat. Children will be able to access Wraparound Care on the same day as a club but please make sure you are booked in advance.

Please request a place, or places, by text. Reply to any message sent to you from Teachers2Parents. We get lots of texts so to make it easier to see your message please begin the text with the word **CLUBS** then Child's name; Class; Name of the Club(s) wanted; if your child can walk home alone or is going on to Wraparound Care; any medical conditions we should be aware of. Eg - **CLUBS - Ann Other, Discoverers, Baking, walk home, Asthma.**

Please make sure you reply by text only, by 3pm on Friday 4th April so that places can be allocated. We will text back to confirm we've got your initial request, so you know we've received it, and we will text again by Wednesday 23rd April, when places have been allocated.

There is no charge for Clubs other than Baking Club (see below).

Please note: This half term we are offering Baking Club to Year 4 only. Each year group will be given the chance over the school year. Payment of £1 per week will be required towards ingredients and this will be requested through SchoolMoney **only** if your child is allocated a place, no payment is needed before places are allocated.

Please note all Clubs are from 3pm-3.45pm apart from Craft Club which is 3-4pm this term.

Please collect children promptly from the main entrance door.
