Dear Parents/Carers of Y6 in September,

It's that time of year where we would like to offer your child the opportunity to go on their final residential trip here at St John's.

We understand your child may have just been on the Y5 trip to London, however to be able to secure our place for the next school year, the company are asking for final numbers already. Due to the current climate, we understand money can be difficult, so at first, we are asking for a non-refundable deposit, then a payment plan will be put in place, to pay throughout the school year.

The trip outlined below will take place from **Monday 15th September to Friday 19th September 2025** and the cost will be £295 per child with school fundraising to help subsidise travel costs. This is for 4 nights and includes:
