Dear Parents/Carers of Year 6

On Tuesday 1st April, we will be visiting The National Holocaust Centre and Museum in Newark to support our Religious Education and PSHE work. We will be exploring the various exhibits and artefacts to learn more about the events and impact of the holocaust. We will be leaving school at 9:15am and aim to return for 3pm, however due to traffic, we may be slightly later. We will of course keep you updated.

For this thought-provoking trip, we are asking for a contribution of £18.50 per child which covers admission, workshops and the coach, which is always a large part of the cost. A payment has been set up on SchoolMoney and the link will be sent to you for permission and payment.

Children will need to wear full school uniform, a coat and sensible footwear. They need to be at school for the usual start time.

If any child suffers from travel sickness, please make sure they take a tablet before the journey and, if medicine is required for the return journey, please inform the office prior to the trip, so that a medication form can be filled in.

Children will need a packed lunch and drink (no glass bottles or fizzy pop please).

NB: Due to severe allergies no egg or nuts please.

If you would like to order a school packed lunch, please do so through Swift Kitchen on the app or via a browser. Children entitled to Free School Meals also need to order this way.

We have two places available on the trip for parent helpers. If you can support us on the day, please Dojo your class teacher. If we have lots of volunteers we will 'pick a name from a hat' and let you know via Class Dojo.
