Dear Parents/Carers

Year 3 are taking a trip to Creswell Crags to support their learning about Stone Age to Iron Age in Britain. During the day they will be taking part in different workshops where the children will learn all about life in the Stone Age up to Iron Age. The trip is on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> December 2025, during usual school hours.

The workshop and coach costs come to £17, so we are asking for a £17 voluntary contribution. A payment has been set up on Arbor, please log in to give permission and make payment.

Children will need to wear full school PE kit, a coat and sensible footwear. We are outdoors for a large part of the day so hat, gloves and a scarf will also be required. They need to be at school for the usual start time and we will be back for normal pick up at 3pm.

If any child suffers from travel sickness, please make sure they take a tablet before the journey and, if medicine is required for the return journey please inform the office prior to the trip, so that a medication form can be filled in.

Children will need a packed lunch and drink (no glass bottles or fizzy pop please).

**NB: Due to severe allergies no egg or nuts please.**
