Dear Parents/Carers of Year 4

This year, we will be learning about the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings. To further our understanding on this topic, we have arranged a trip to Perlethorpe on Monday 2nd March to experience life in the Anglo-Saxon and Viking times. There will be outdoor activities all day so warm clothing and suitable footwear are essential!

Children will learn about the events of the Saxon invaders and how they came to settle in England, about important leaders, gods and how things changed when the Vikings invaded.

The total cost of the entrance, activities and coach will come to £11 per child. A payment has been set up on Arbor.

Children will need to wear full school uniform with a suitable coat and sensible footwear. They need to be at school for the usual start time and we will be back for normal pick up at 3pm.

If any child suffers from travel sickness, please make sure they take a tablet before the journey and, if medicine is required for the return journey, please inform the office prior to the trip, so that a medication form can be filled in.

Children will need a packed lunch and drink (no glass bottles or fizzy pop please).

NB: Due to severe allergies no egg or nuts please.
